

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We are learning to:

- Understand how we grow and change
- Understand how to keep healthy through food, exercise, sleep, hygiene and sensible screen time
- Manage feelings and emotions regarding transition to Year 1
- Recognise the progress we have made this year and set targets for next year

### Physical Development

We are learning to:

- Play team games - listening to and following instructions, turn taking, problem solving

- Recognise and order numbers to 20
- Count backwards from 20
- Add and subtract within 20
- Recognise and recall doubles
- Recall number bonds to 10 and their related subtraction facts
- Order, measure and compare by length, height, weight, capacity, time
- Name and describe 2d and 3d shapes
