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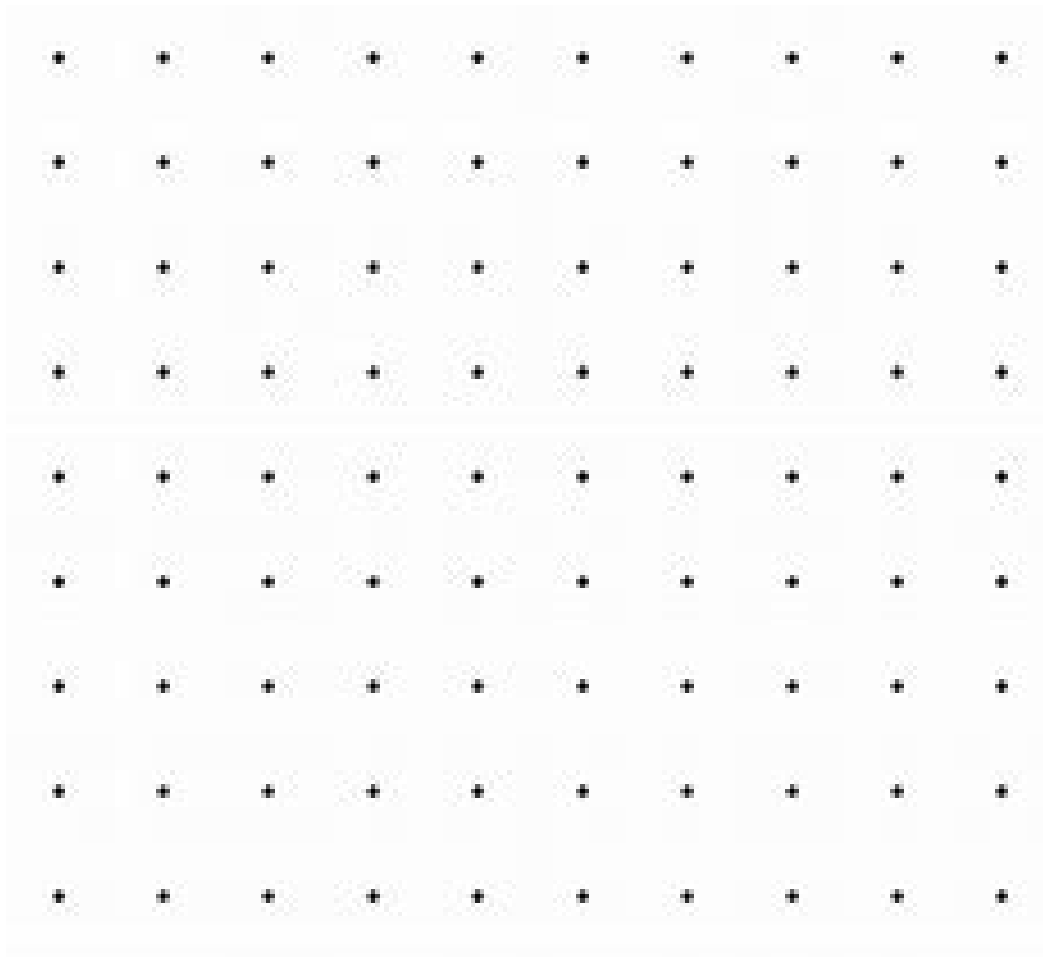

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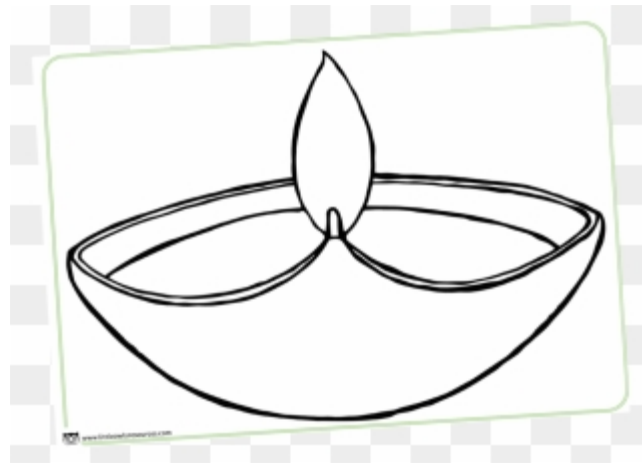
The story of Rama and Sita is remembered at the festival of Diwali. Hindu families prepare for Diwali by cleaning their house and creating Rangoli patterns near the door of their house. Rangoli patterns are very brightly coloured. They are often symmetrical.

Use the dotted grid to create a Rangoli pattern?



The people from Rama and Sita's kingdom lit lamps to help them find their way home. These lamps are known as diya lamps. They help Hindus to remember that light triumphs over darkness and good triumphs over evil.
