Vulnerable children are those who may need extra help, care, or protection to stay safe, happy, and able to learn.

Categories of vulnerable children:

- Children living in poverty – those who may not always have enough food, clothes, or resources.
- Children with disabilities or special needs – those who need extra support to learn or play.
- Children who feel unsafe – those who may face neglect, bullying, or harm.
- Children who are new to the country – those who may struggle with language or adjusting to a new culture.
- Children in care – those looked after by foster families or social services instead of their parents.
