What do we already know?

Topic Page - Prior knowledge, What do we already know? Where is France?

France

- What is France?
- Where is France?
- What do you know about their culture?
- Finding France on a map
- What does their flag look like?

How do you greet someone in French?

- Understand how you say hello to someone in French
- Understand how you ask someone how they are in French
- Practice through roleplay these greetings with responses

What is your name?

- Understand how you ask what someone's name is
- Understand how to answer the question 'what is your name?'
- Apply the greetings you have learnt by introducing yourself to the class

Numbers 1 - 10

- Count 1 - 10 in French
- Spell numbers 1 - 10 in French

Colours

- Identify and name 10 colours in French
- Read and spell colours in French

Recap

- How do you greet someone in French?
- How do you ask someone their name and tell you yours?
- How do you ask someone how they are?
- Can you count to 10 in French?
- Can you name 10 colours in French?

Term 2 – Animals

- Identify an animal from hearing the word spoken to you

Les animaux

- Recap the 5 animals taught in French
- Can you identify any of the animals labelled in French? (next lot of 5)
- Identify an animal from hearing the word spoken to you

Indefinite article or determiner?

- Recap the 10 animals taught in French
- What is an indefinite article/ determiner?
- Identify the correct indefinite article/ determiner with the right animal name

Je suis

- What does 'Je suis' mean?
- Recap the 10 animals in French, reading and orally rehearsing
- Apply your knowledge of fruits by orally rehearsing sentences saying what fruits you like

Recap

- What animals can you say in French?
- Read, say and write 10 animals in French, using the correct indefinite article/ determiner
- Respond with a simple phrase or sentence to a question

Term 3 – Instruments

What do we already know?

Topic Page - Prior knowledge, What do we already know? Do you know any instrument words in French?

Les instruments

- What does les instruments mean?
- Can you identify any of the instruments labelled in French? (max 5)
- Identify an instrument from hearing and reading the word

Les instruments

- Recap the 5 instruments taught last time
- Can you identify any of the instruments labelled in French? (next lot of 5)
- Identify an instrument from hearing and reading the word (all 10)

How many can you remember?

- Recap the 10 instruments taught in French
- Identify the correct instrument after hearing the word spoken to you
- Identify the correct instrument after reading it

Je joue

- Recap the 10 instruments in French, reading and orally rehearsing the words
- What does 'Je joue' mean?
- Apply your knowledge of instruments by orally rehearsing sentences saying what instruments you play

Recap

- What instruments can you say in French?
- Read, say and write 10 instruments in French, using the correct indefinite article/ determiner
- Respond with a simple phrase or sentence to a question about what instrument you play

Learning Flow

Term 4 – I am able

What do we already know?

Topic Page - Prior knowledge, What do we already know? Do you know any verbs in French?

What do you like to do?

- What does je peux mean?
- Can you identify any of the verbs labelled in French? (max 5)
- Identify a verb from hearing and reading the word

What do you like to do?

- Recap the 5 verbs taught last time
- Can you identify any of the 5 new verbs in French?
- Identify a verb from hearing and reading the word (all 10)

Je peux

- Recap the 10 verbs
- What do you like to do?
- Orally rehearse a sentence using je peux and the action you like to do

Je ne peux pas

- What do you like to do? Orally respond to the question in French
- What does je ne peux pas mean?
- What do you not like to do?
- Orally rehearse a sentence using je ne peux pas and the action you do not like to do

Et and Mais

- What does et mean?
- What does mais mean?
- Can you say a sentence about what you like/ do not like to do using the words et or mais?

Recap

- What verbs can you say in French?
- Read, say and write 10 verbs in French
- Respond in a sentence to a question about what you like to do and what you don't like to do
- Use the conjunctions et and mais to extend your responses

Learning Flow

Term 5 – Fruits

What do we already know?

Topic Page - Prior knowledge, What do we already know? Do you know any names of fruits in French?

Les Fruits

- What does les fruits mean?
- Can you identify any of the fruits labelled in French?
- Identify a fruit from hearing the work spoken to you

Singular and plural

- Understand how you change a noun into its singular and plural form
- Read and say 10 different fruits in French in their singular and plural form

J'aime...

- Recap what 'j'aime' means in French
- Apply your knowledge of fruits by orally rehearsing sentences saying what fruits you like

Je n'aime pas...

- Recap what je n'aime pas means
- Apply your knowledge of fruits by orally rehearsing sentences saying which fruits you don't like

Ést-ce que tu aimes...

- Understand how you say which fruits you like and don't like in a sentence
- Ask the question 'do you like...?' in French
- Roleplay asking and answering questions

Recap

- How many of the 10 fruits can you name?
- How do you say you like a certain fruit?
- How do you say you don't like a certain fruit?
- Can you ask a fruit if they like a certain fruit?
- How do you answer that question?

Term 5 – Ice creams

What do we already know?

Topic Page - Prior knowledge, What do we already know? Do you know any flavours in French?



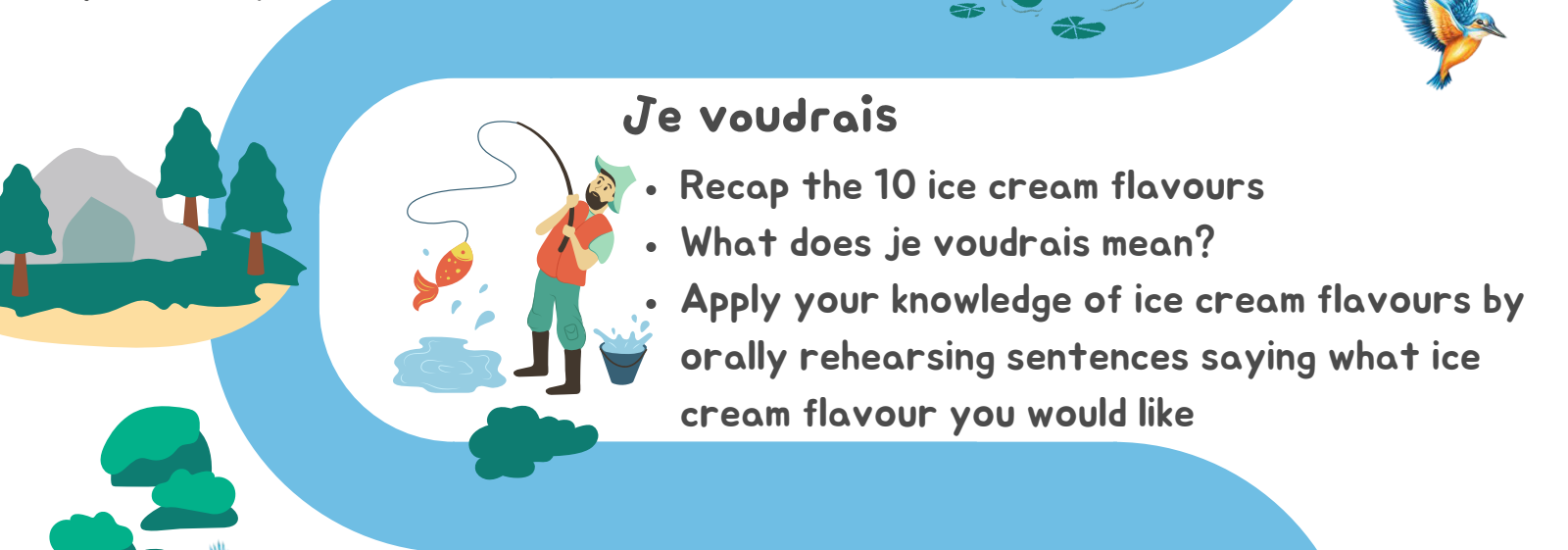
Les glaces

- What does les glaces mean?
- Orally rehearse 5 different flavours
- Identify a flavour from hearing the word spoken to you
- Can you say the flavour in French after seeing a visual?



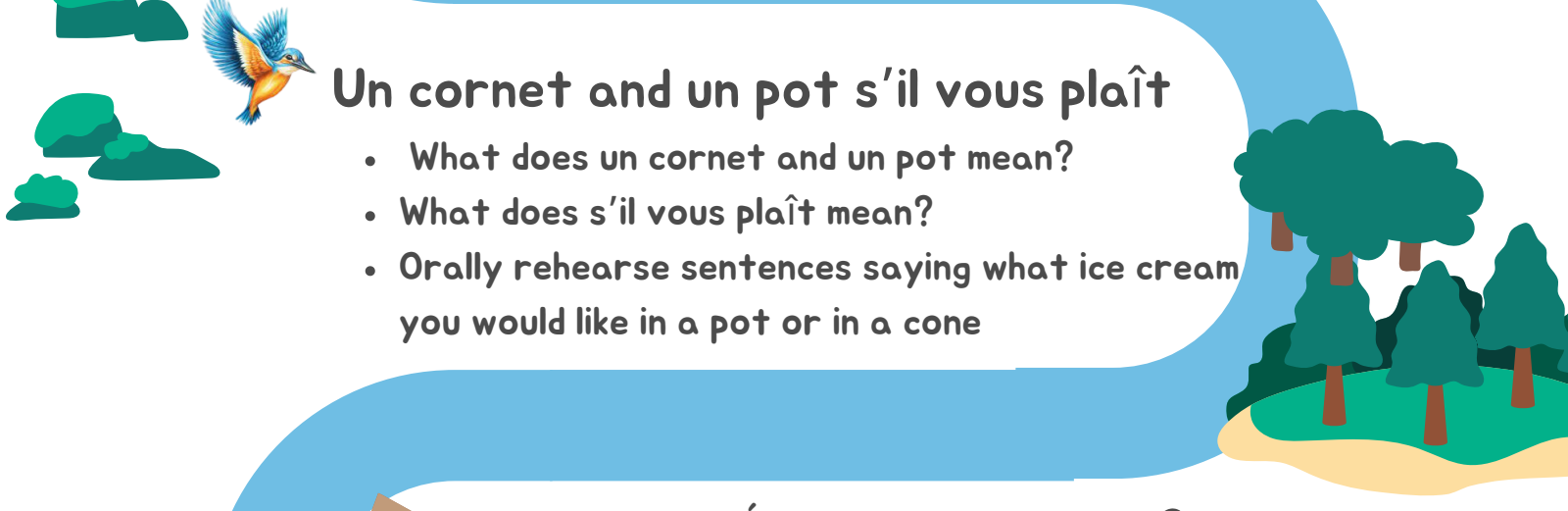
Les glaces

- Recap the 5 flavours taught last time
- Orally rehearse 5 more flavours of ice cream
- Can you say the flavour in French after seeing a visual?
- Can you identify the flavour after hearing it spoken to you?



Je voudrais

- Recap the 10 ice cream flavours
- What does je voudrais mean?
- Apply your knowledge of ice cream flavours by orally rehearsing sentences saying what ice cream flavour you would like



Un cornet and un pot s'il vous plaît

- What does un cornet and un pot mean?
- What does s'il vous plaît mean?
- Orally rehearse sentences saying what ice cream you would like in a pot or in a cone



Combien de boules?

- Understand what combien de boules? means and how to answer the question
- Orally rehearse answering the question using all the vocabulary taught so far

Recap

- How many of the 10 flavours of ice cream can you name?
- How do you say you would like a certain ice cream flavour?
- How do you say you would like a cone or a pot?
- Can you answer the question combien de boules?
