Choose 1 activity to complete each week. These activities are optional but it would be great to share some of their home learning at the end of the term.

This term's value: Psalm 1:3

- Create a piece of artwork inspired by the verse.
- Create a poem linking to Psalm 1:3.
- Share with someone what we say as part of our collective worship and what it means.

Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Create a character you might find in a fantasy narrative. You might want to research some KS2 fantasy books to give you some ideas.	Write a letter to yourself to open on your last day of year 3 or 4. Write in it what you hope will happen, what you want to learn, what you are excited about or what you think you will achieve while being in year 3 or 4.
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Play a communication game: Story chain, guess the object or 21 questions.	Practice saying months of the year and seasons. Can you create a game to help you remember?
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Explore Topmarks and some place value games: https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-games/7-11-years/place- value	Times Table homework (weekly)
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Create a model of the water cycle.	Research famous mountains and rivers around the world. Present this in a creative way.
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Go on a walk and draw the landscape around you. Can you think about colours, textures, perspective?	Find some music played by a violin. Reflect- What do you like about it? What do you notice? Can you find any famous violin players?
STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Be a scientist: Investigate what happens to water when it is heated, cooled and frozen. What do you notice? Can you record your findings?	Be a scientist: can you investigate forces? Drop a light and heavy object, which one will land first? Can you draw a diagram with labels? Share with someone what you noticed.
Living in the wider world (RE & PSHE)	We are Citizens and Theologians!	Find a Bible story and recreate it. Create an animation, comic strip, own version, audio book or podcast.	Create poster about your strengths, personal qualities and goals for the year.
