Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Write a diary entry from the perspective of Tom once realises the effects of the unending winter. Try and include speech and relevant nouns!	Write a poem inspired by the Earth just like Poems From A Green & Blue Planet!
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Create a dominoes game where you match up French and English words.	Have a conversation with someone about their favourite colour, remember greetings!
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Measure and record different object's lengths and calculate their perimeter.	Times Table homework (weekly)
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Create a fact file of the different climates around the world.	Research animals you would find in polar regions (Y3) or the rainforest (Y4). Present this in a creative way!
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Draw a landscape with a vanishing point. Can you include a focus point and horizon to demonstrate perspective?	Listen to Silent Night on the violin, what notes are they playing? Could you play this?
STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Y3 Be a scientist: go outside at different times of day and in different locations, what do you notice about your shadow? Y4 Be a scientist: Draw a food chain and label the different parts. Can you write a sentence to explain how certain living things depend on one another to survive?	Draw a catapult and label the fulcrum, effort and load.
Living in the wider world (RE & PSHE)	We are Citizens and Theologians!	Create a comic strip of the Christmas story.	Create a table with the headings 'Respectful' and 'Not respectful'. Add in your own scenarios to demonstrate your understanding of respect.
