Choose 1 activity to complete each week. These activities are optional but it would be great to share some of your home learning at the end of the term.

<u>Values</u>

Psalm 1.3 - 'A tree planted by streams of water which yields its fruit in season.'
Can you create a tree of Life?

- Create a tree using paper, cardboard, or natural materials.
- Write or draw 'fruits' on the branches that represent growth (e.g., love, patience, kindness).
- Add 'roots' that show spiritual disciplines (e.g., prayer, Bible reading, community).

Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Write a description of a character from a fairy tale and draw a picture to illustrate it.	Watch a fairy tale film, can you spot a princess, a wicked character, talking animals, things happening in 3s, a setting of a wood, castle or cottage.
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Learn a simple poem by heart.	Learn how to say hello, how are you in a different language to what you speak at home.
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Find numbers around the house (house number, how many pieces of fruit, numbers on tee shirts/sports kits, how many fingers and toes in total, the time in minutes on a clock, any numbers written down) Write them down and put them in order from smallest to largest.	Practice counting backwards in 2s, 5s and 10s.
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Find out about something invented in either the reign of Queen Elizabeth 1, Queen Victoria or Queen Elizabeth II.	Make a model of a crown, what symbols and colours will you use.
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Use different objects in the house to make a pattern of short and long sounds.	Go outside and find some leaves, do a leaf rubbing with crayons to show the shape and texture.
STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Write a true false quiz about your favourite animal.	Be a scientist: find out some animals that belong to the main groups: mammals, amphibians, reptiles, fish and birds. Present your work in an interesting way.
Living in the wider world (RE & PSHE)	We are Citizens and Role Models!	Find out about some different symbols used in different religions.	Create a poster to remind us about being a good friend.
