Reading & Writing	We are Authors!	Find and read a story by our Author of the term - Mini Grey	Can you write a poem about your family?
Communication and Language	We are Linguists & Communicators!	Can you learn the days of the week in a different language and then teach the rest of the class?	Can you learn to fingerspell your name in British Sign Language?
Maths	We are Mathematicians!	Can you find different containers in your house and use a measuring jug to see how much water they hold? (Do this on a sunny day outside or in the bath!)	How could you show fractions using objects such as lego, pasta, cars or playdough. What fractions could you make?
Understanding the world (Geography & History)	We are Historians & Geographers!	Can you find out how many countries there are in Africa?  Have a look at their flags, can you find out what the colours and symbols mean? Could you present what you have found out to share with the class.	Can you write a letter to a Child of hope school pupil telling them about your life in Swindon?
Expressive arts and design (Art & Music)	We are Artists & Musicians!	Create a piece of Artwork inspired by Henri Matisse.	Matisse enjoyed listening to Jazz music, can you listen to any music by Courtney Pine. What does it make you think of? Feel? Can you make a cut out inspired by the music? (Courtney Pine plays Misty Later archive)
STEM (Science & DT)	We are Scientists & Engineers!	Research and create a traditional Ugandan textile pattern.	Take photographs of a seedling growing into an adult plant over a series of weeks. Can you spot the different stages of the life cycle?
