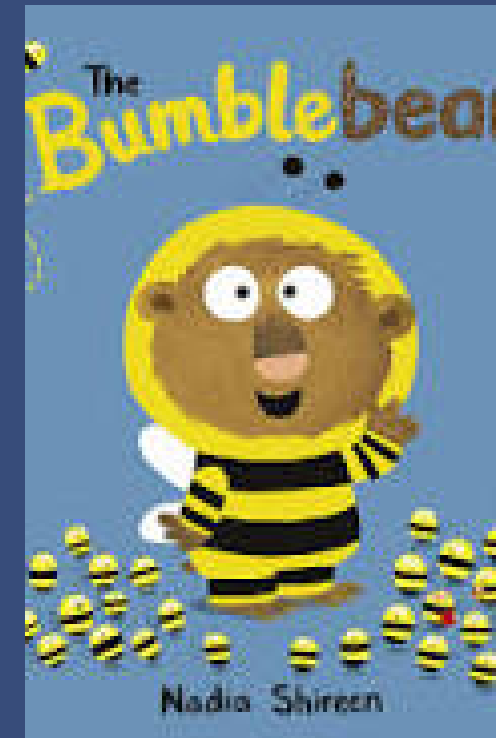
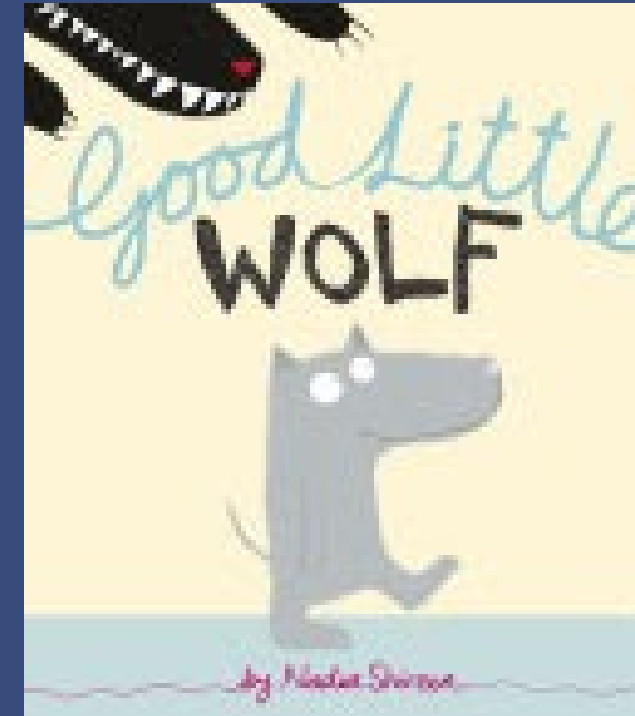
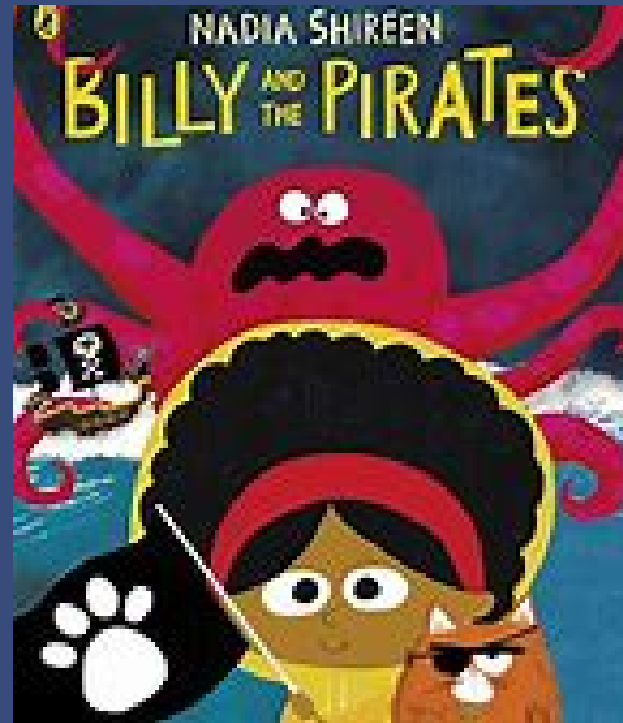
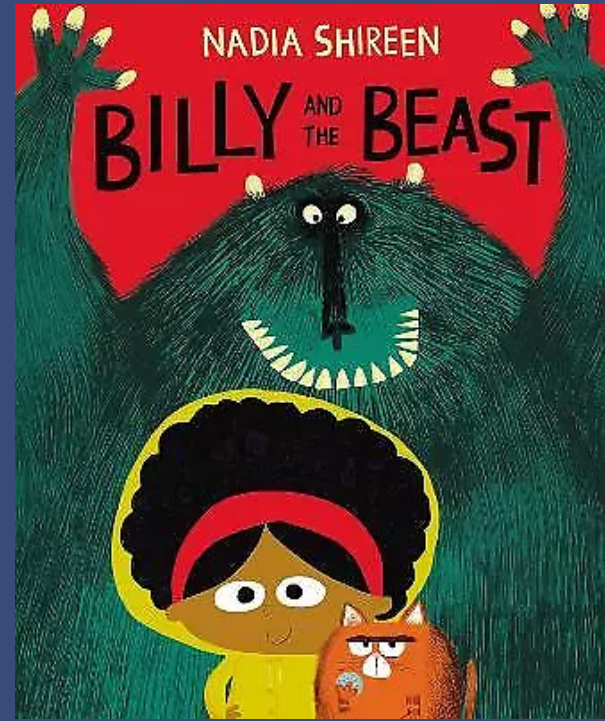
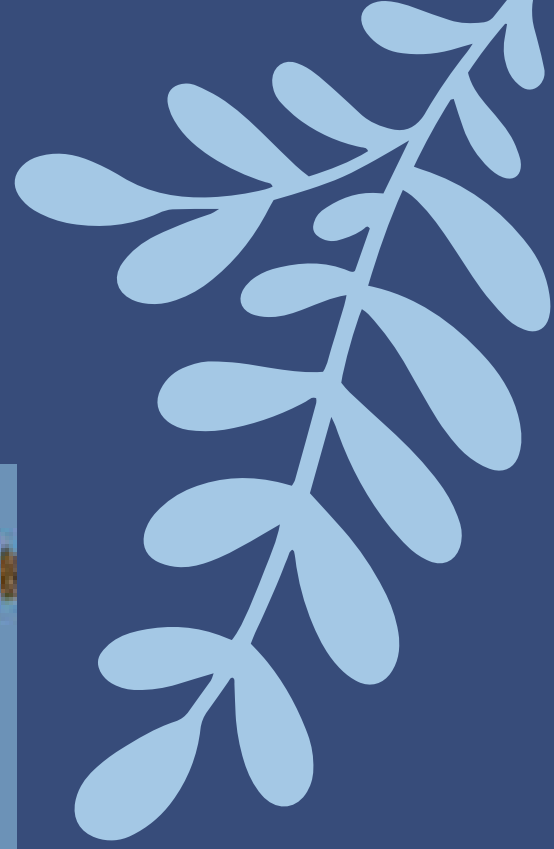
We will be learning for


Nadia Shireen
