Sessions

Our sessions run from 8:30am until 15:00pm Monday to Friday. We are term time only.

Morning session - 8:30am until 11:30am

Afternoon session- 12:00pm until 15:00pm

All Day session - 8:30 until 15:00pm

We accept all types of government funding from two years of age.

You can also purchase additional sessions.

Two year old session - £18

Three year old session - £15

We require a minimum of 4 sessions per week to help support your child when settling and with their learning. If you would like to change your sessions, we require 4 weeks written notice.

Snack

Children are encouraged to try a variety of foods during snack time. The Nursery staff ensure that snack time is a fun and engaging experience by involving the children in the preparation process, such as spreading their own butter or hummus. The snack is reliant on donations from parents. There is a tub available for donations. Anything you can contribute is greatly received.

Please make sure the school is informed and updated of any allergies or dietary requirements. This can be done via the school office.

Lunch

Lunch at the nursery is between 11:30am and 12:00pm. You can order a meal for a small fee using the School Food United app or provide a packed lunch instead. Please note that we are a nut-free school.

Tapestry

To track your child's learning and development at Nursery, we use an app called Tapestry. This online platform serves as a learning journey, allowing us to upload photographs and observations. Additionally, you can contribute by uploading your own photos and comments, sharing your experiences and activities at home.

Sickness

if your child is unwell, please contact the school before 9.00am on the day of absence informing the school of the reason for absence. As part of our safeguarding procedures, the school office will endeavour to contact the parent, carer or other emergency contacts if no message has been received regarding the reason for the absence and to check on the safety of the child.

If your child is absent due to vomiting or diarrhoea, they should not return to school for the next 48 hours after the last bout of sickness. This is to reduce the risk of infection to other children and adults at school.

Attendance

Regular attendance at Nursery is important for your child's development. If your child is absent due to illness, holiday or for any other circumstance, please let us know as soon as possible. Unfortunately, we are unable to refund fees for missed sessions but exceptional circumstances will be considered on an individual basis.
